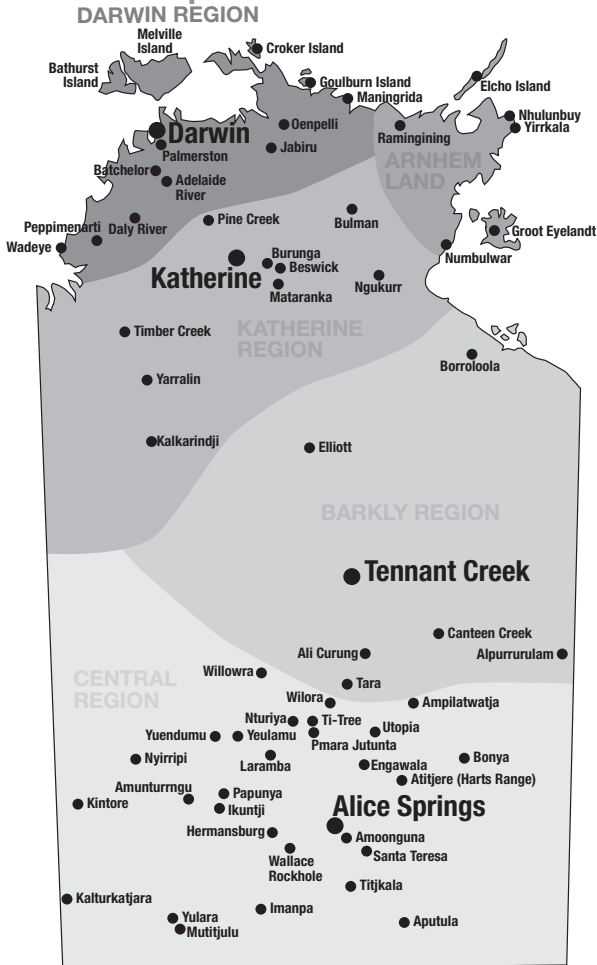

How to use this publication?

The services that people should be contacting will be determined by the type of problem they are facing. If it is not obvious at first glance one should read the first chapter and attempt to find a question that is similar to the question being asked. Each question in chapter one is addressed by detailing the types of services that will be able to assist in answering the question.

Once the type of service is identified the user should proceed to chapter two where they will find a list of all of the relevant support services listed according to region. If you cannot find a service in that district then you may have to attempt to locate an appropriate service in a nearby district. If there are no services within a reasonable distance, then it would be appropriate to contact a service which provides telephone assistance.

Which service do I need?

This chapter is designed to help people identify the services that may be of assistance to them.

When do I need...

Counselling?

Separation is one of the most emotionally traumatic processes a person can go through in their lives. Often the source of the problems encountered during separation are a result of the emotions that the parties are experiencing. It is for this reason that Counselling, Mediation and Family Dispute Resolution Services are vital to resolving disputes following separation. If you are having difficulties dealing with the trauma of separation, it is advisable that you contact your nearest counselling service and book an appointment.

Mediation and Family Dispute Resolution?

Reaching an agreement about property or children can be difficult following separation. If you are having difficulty discussing issues with your former partner, family dispute resolution may be of assistance. A Family Dispute Resolution Practitioner is able to assist parties to reach an agreement. The role of the Family Dispute Resolution Practitioner is to help the parties communicate and encourage the parties to create their own solutions.

Legal advice?

Getting legal advice is an important first step should any problems arise. Family Law is often an area of law that is riddled with misconceptions. For example it is said that because of changes to the law, both parents are given equal care of the children. This generalisation is incorrect and it is for this reason that separating parties should seek legal advice.

There are many legal services that can offer free legal advice over the phone (for remote areas only) or in clinics on family law issues. They include:

- Central Australian Women's Legal Service (CAWLS)
- Domestic Violence Legal Service (located in both Darwin and Alice Springs)
- Katherine Women's Information and Legal Service (KWILS)
- North Australian Aboriginal Family Violence Legal Service (NAAFVLS)

Private law firms will also be able to provide legal advice but their services are not free. The Northern Territory Law Society runs a first interview scheme where clients are able to have an initial interview with a private practitioner at a reduced cost. The Law Society can advise on the current cost of the scheme and the practitioners who are participating in the scheme.

Which service do I need? continued...

Who can I talk to...

About our property?

Following separation, it is necessary for the property that has been accumulated jointly to be divided between the parties. If there is any significant property it is essential that each party obtain legal advice. Knowing your entitlement and rights is essential to enable an agreement to be reached. Contact your nearest legal service or private solicitor to arrange an appointment.

About child welfare?

Welfare concerns about children can include child abuse, neglect, sexual abuse, truancy, exposure to danger, lack of nutrition, and others. Notify NT Families and Children (NTFC) and/or your local police station.

About Child Support?

Every parent is responsible for financially and emotionally supporting their children whether they live with them or not. The level of support is determined by a number of factors including the number of children, their care arrangements and the income of both parents. You should contact the Child Support Agency to discuss your options on 131 272.

About Domestic Violence?

If there has been a recent incident of violence then the Police should be contacted first. If a person is in fear of violence then they should approach their nearest Domestic Violence Service for legal advice. Support and counselling are also available through counselling services.

About getting help with housing?

Following separation many people find themselves without a place to stay until they can arrange their own housing. If you find yourself in need of housing there are many organisations that can help. Crisis accommodation is provided for persons and families who are in need of urgent temporary accommodation. Most of these organisations can also arrange or refer you to other services that provide longer term accommodation.

About moving interstate?

Every person has the right to move freely throughout Australia as provided in the Constitution. If the person wishing to relocate has children then legal advice is strongly recommended before any move. Persons should note that a Court is able to order that the children be returned to their place of origin in some circumstances.

About getting help with money?

Many people experiencing separation find themselves in financial difficulty and often need a little money to help them get back on their feet. There are many charity organisations that can help with donations as well as government departments that can issue urgent grants, loans and advanced benefit payments. Contact your nearest charity or counselling service to find out more information.

About going to court?

Going to court should always be a last resort but if it is absolutely necessary then obtaining legal advice is essential. Contact your nearest legal service for free advice. There are also many support services that can assist people who are going through the courts. Some of these services include:

What if I reach an agreement about...

The Children?

Most parents who have separated reach their own verbal agreements about where the children will live and when the other parent will have contact with the children. It is not necessary to have a formal agreement in most situations, but if the parties feel that they require something in writing then they have two options:

Parenting Plans

A parenting plan is a written agreement, which is signed by the parents. A parenting plan cannot be filed with the Family Court and is therefore not an enforceable Court Order. It can only be used in the Family Court to show the intention of the parties. Various Family Dispute Resolution services help parties draft parenting plans after an agreement is reached.

Consent Orders

Court Orders can be made by consent by filing an Application for Consent Orders with the Family Court. A Consent Orders Kit can be obtained from the Family Court, or at www.familycourt.gov.au. The kit contains the Application as well as instructions on how to fill it out.

If you have any difficulties in reaching an agreement you should then try Family Dispute Resolution. If Family Dispute Resolution fails then it may be necessary to get some legal advice.

Our Property?

If parties can reach an agreement on their own about the distribution of the property it will save them time, money and distress. It is important to ensure that you have obtained legal advice and given full disclosure of all assets prior to reaching any agreement. If the parties are married, or in a defacto relationship, it is advisable to file the agreement with the Family Court by completing a Consent Orders Kit. These kits are available from the Court.

Child Support?

Parties are able to reach their own agreements for Child Support payments. It is advisable that the parties lodge the agreement with the Child Support Agency. Not all agreements will be enforced by the Child Support Agency. Please contact the Agency for further information. Parties should always seek legal advice before reaching any agreement for lump sum Child Support, or signing a child support agreement.
